

## BRITISH ORIENTEERING - NEW MEMBERSHIP STRUCTURE

As indicated in various British Orienteering publications and The Navigator, there is to be a new membership structure for 2007.

There are now 2 levels of British Orienteering membership above normal BAOC Club membership: NATIONAL and LOCAL. The benefits and fees of each of these levels are shown in the table below. In return for an annual fee, a member is entitled to a £2 discount for certain civilian events as shown on the table below: the discount for some 3 to 8 individual event entries per year will cover the cost of British Orienteering Membership (based on SENIOR membership).

### Notes:

1. Those who have not been a member of an orienteering club during the last three years and join after 31 August 2006, will get free Local Membership to the end of 2007.
2. A Local member may upgrade to National membership during the course of the year by paying the difference in the appropriate fee.
3. A new National member joining after 31 August 2006, will pay the 2007 subscription which will carry through to the end of 2007.
4. The Club member rate and relevant British Orienteering membership rate added are added to produce an annual figure (see final column).
