MEMBERSHIP DETAILS

1. If making an alteration or you are a lapsed member, please quote your British Orienteering Membership number.
2. All memberships last for one fixed calendar year i.e. 1 Jan - 31 Dec, no matter when you join during the year. If you join after 1 September the membership will last until the end of the following year i.e. up to 16 months), but the following year's membership rates will apply.
3. Membership is available at three levels:
 - a. **Club Only.** This means joining just BAOC and receiving our club newsletter 'THE NAVIGATOR', which gives detailed coverage of mainly Army orienteering and other benefits.
 - b. **National Member of British Orienteering.** This type of membership is recommended for anyone intending to orienteer at civilian events. British Orienteering National members get reduced entry fees in all regions and other benefits. Full details are on the "New to Orienteering" pages at www.britishorienteering.org.uk.
 - c. **Local Member of British Orienteering.** This type of membership is for anyone intending to orienteer at local civilian events. Local members get reduced entry fees to certain events only in their own region.
4. Choose a British Orienteering regional association from the list at the bottom of the page and enter it in block 2 of the form; this can be any region (where you are stationed or your home area). If no preference given, SCOA will be assumed. N.B. For Local Members this affects where you receive discounts on event fees.

AGE GROUPING AND TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Members are grouped according to age class eg M/W35. All classes being entered on 1 Jan of the year in which you reach the relevant age. Senior is anyone over 21; Junior is anyone under 21, or full time student. Family membership is parents/guardians and any person under 25 living at same permanent address.

JUNIORS = M/W 10,12,14,16,18 and 20. SENIOR = M/W 21,35,40,45,50,55,60,65,70 etc.

Other Clubs. Members of BAOC can also be club members of another club eg Warrior OC (WAROC). Vice-versa, if you are a member of BOF through another club, you can also be a member of BAOC.
