

## **EXPORTING COURSE DETAILS FROM OCAD**

Note: For a Regional Event, take care that the courses are numbered so that they match the event file setup. Generally it is best to follow the numbering scheme in the British Orienteering Guideline for Regional or National Events.

### ***In OCAD 9***

Note: Courses must be set up using OCAD's Course Setting Project feature

- 1) Choose menu item **COURSE > EXPORT > COURSES VERSION 8 (TEXT)**  
- **make sure you select the Version 8 option!**
- 2) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and click on Save to create the course export file. By default the file will be saved in the same folder as the Ocad map file.

### ***In OCAD 8***

Note: Courses must be set up using OCAD's Course Setting Project feature

- 1) Choose menu item **FILE > EXPORT COURSES**
- 2) In the Export Courses dialog box, ensure Courses is selected and then click on OK.
- 3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and click on Save to create the course export file. By default the file will be saved in the same folder as the Ocad map file.

## **EXPORTING COURSE DETAILS FROM CONDES**

### ***IN CONDES 8:***

- 1) Choose menu item **EXPORT > EXPORT EVENT DATA > IOF XML FORMAT**
- 2) All courses available should be ticked, File Type should be IOF Version 2.0. Click on the EXPORT button.
- 3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and save the file as a XML file.

### ***IN CONDES 7:***

- 1) Choose menu item **FILE > EXPORT DATA > CLASSIC FORMAT**
- 2) All courses available should be ticked, File Type should be IOF Version 2.0. Click on the EXPORT button.
- 3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and save the file as a DAT file.
